ACADEMY AT BRADENTON *COMING SOON*

After months of dreaming and planning, we are excited to announce the expansion of services into Manatee County with the creation of Academy at Bradenton.

Since our inception in 2017, we have received requests from applicants and residents of Manatee County for greater accessibility to our services. With public transportation as the primary means of getting back and forth, many Manatee residents have found travel time between counties to be prohibitive.

With a stroke of good luck, we identified an ideal property in downtown Bradenton with easy access to businesses and county offices, just a block from the Manatee’s Downtown Transit Station. Slated to open late fall, 2022, Academy at Bradenton will be located in a 7,500 sq. ft. historic building situated at 601 12th Street West, Bradenton, FL, 34205, right across from the Courthouse on Main Street. Interior remodeling has begun and will include the creation of a commercial kitchen as well as arts, multimedia, business and technology training areas.

Beginning next month, in July, we will be offering services in a rental property at Connect Central, located 1201 6th Avenue West, Bradenton, across the street from our remodel. Jeffrey Jean will transfer from Sarasota to Bradenton as our program director. He will be accompanied by Vanessa Alcantara, of our Business & Tech team. They have begun active enrollment of Manatee applicants.

We are grateful for our continued collaboration with Central Florida Behavioral Health Network, one of our core funding partners. We would also like to recognize the technical assistance of Clubhouse International, and the generous support of Bank of America, the Manatee Matches Giving Circle and Manatee Community Foundation.
