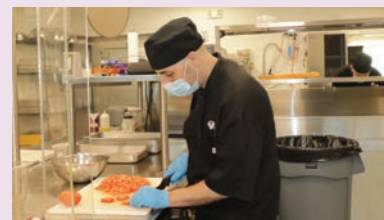
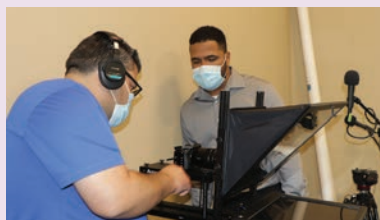

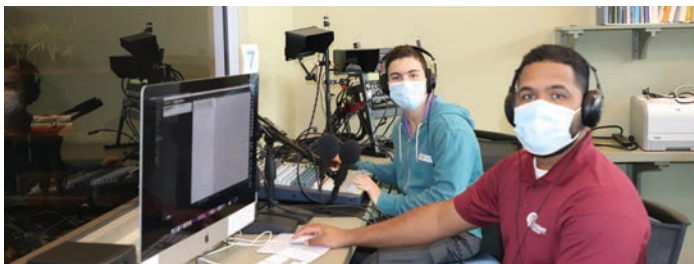
MULTIMEDIA ON THE MOVE
