Business & Technology

Technology skills are an essential part of 21st century workplace. Our Business & Technology area is the administrative and customer service hub of the Academy at Bradenton. Here, members build customer service skills by managing the welcome desk, answering and routing calls,

and providing comprehensive tours of our facility. Office and computer-based skills are developed through data entry, accounting, and myriad other tasks integral to our smooth operation. This area utilizes interactive display boards, tablets, and PC's equipped with Microsoft Office suite, QuickBooks, and our Flourish database.



Graphic Design & Multimedia

The creative potential of Academy members knows no limits. In our Media Center, members create marketing collateral, newsletters, flyers and business cards. A state-of-the-art multimedia studio provides members with the tools to script and shoot original videos and still photography.

Members in this area also manage the Academy's website and social media accounts. This area uses iMac's, PC's, interactive display boards and tablets, equipped with Adobe Creative Suite and Final Cut Pro.

Culinary Arts

Nutrition and wellness are top priorities in the recovery process. Members in Culinary Arts prepare daily breakfast and lunch options for the Academy community in our commercial instructional kitchen. Our noontime meal offers healthy selections of entrée, soup and salad, as well as "to go" options. Additionally, members work as wait staff and use industry-standard point-of-sale system to transmit orders to the kitchen, track orders and take payments. This area also focuses on proper cleaning and sanitizing.



Careers

The Academy provides members with the opportunity to enter the workforce and embark on a career. Based on a step-wise approach to workforce integration, the Academy offers Transitional, Supported and Independent Employment opportunities tailored to meet individual member

needs. Academy job coaches provide assistance with resumé development, interviewing skills, on-the-job training as well as continued job supports following placement.
